HOURS: Wednesdays 9AM-12PM, 3rd Tuesday of each month 5PM-7PM, and last Saturday of each month 10AM-12PM; Dining Room is open Monday to Thursday from 11AM-1PM and Friday 9:30AM-1PM for dine-in or to-go meals.

IDENTIFICATION: ID or proof of address for the pantry; Everyone is

welcome for the meal site.

HOW OFTEN CAN SOMEONE VISIT: 2x per month for the pantry; every day for hot meal; one meal per day per person for the community kitchen.

HOW TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT: No appointment is needed during pantry hours, but you can call if you have an urgent food need outside of those hours. Please use the entrance on Dorr Ave.
