- Copies of Driver's License/Government issued photo I.D. for you and your spouse
- If married and filing a joint return SPOUSE MUST BE PRESENT
- Social Security Card(s) for you, your spouse and ALL dependents
- For Direct Deposit Bring a voided check, or a Savings Account Number with Routing Number
- Last year's state and federal tax return
- Please bring all documents that prove source of income W-2s, 1098s,1099s etc.
- Student loan statements simple statement
- Information for all deductions and credits
- All HSA (Health Savings Account) documentation
- Child & Dependent Care Expense Day Care Statement (must include Tax Identification Number SSN, EIN) of the care provider. Individuals who provide daycare services need to provide their Social Security number.
- Property Tax Credit –For the elderly and disabled only. Rent Receipts or canceled check and landlords name & complete address. If you own your own home, bring your Real Estate Property Tax Statement.
- Combined income may not exceed \$67,000
- Please call at least 48 hours prior if you need to cancel or reschedule your appointment
